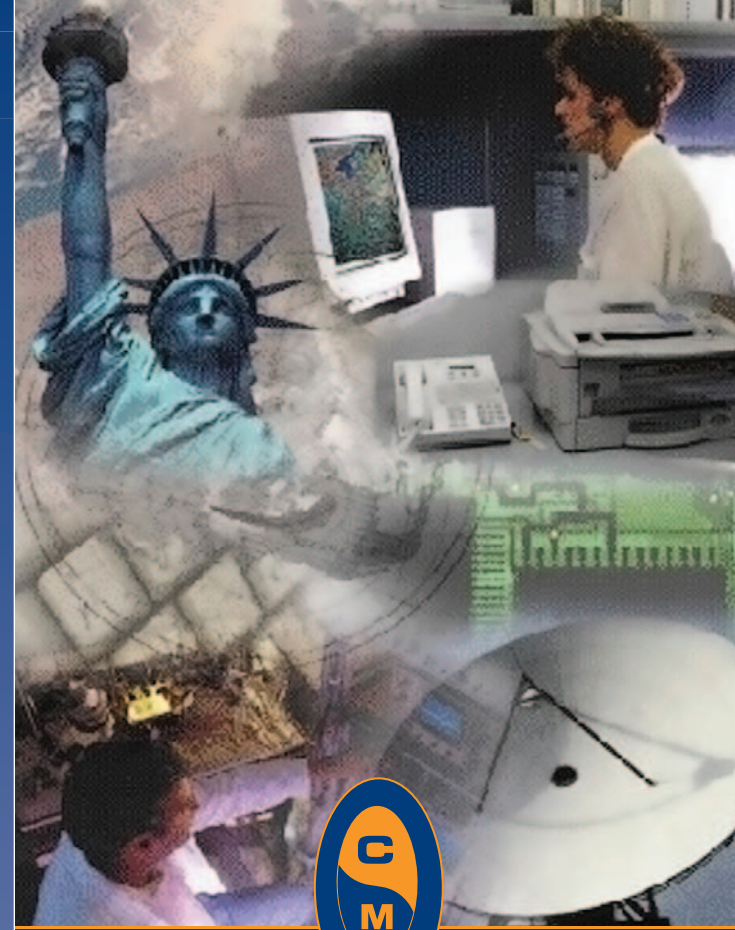

WHAT IS THE NATIONAL CLASSIFICATION MANAGEMENT SOCIETY (NCMS)?

NCMS was founded in 1964 by a group of government and industry security classification managers and administrators who recognized the importance of establishing a society, national in scope, to advance the practice of Classification Management as a profession.

Today, the Society has over 3,000 members in the United States and overseas including representatives from NATO countries. Within the U.S., members come from the Department of Energy, Department of Defense, Department of State, National Aeronautics and Space Administration, Federal Bureau of Investigation, National Security Agency, General Accounting Office—virtually every Federal agency that deals with classification—and from the civilian contractors who work with these agencies. As the Society has grown over the years, its focus has also expanded. NCMS now provides professional development for its members in the field of classification management, information security, personnel security, computer security, operations security (OPSEC), facility security, and technology security.

In 2005, the 41st Board of Directors decided to adopt a new brand for the Society to better reflect the focus of the organization and its members. Therefore, in March 2005, NCMS became NCMS, Inc. -- the Society of Industrial Security Professionals. Although the “NCMS” is no longer spelled out, it was kept to honor the history of the organization and because of name recognition. Thus, “NCMS” honors our history and represents the “old”, while the byline, “the Society of Industrial Security Professionals”, represents the “new”.

In 2009, the 45th Board of Directors redefined the Society’s previous purpose and scope into a new vision and mission to better reflect the goals and objectives of the organization, as well as the changing role of the security professional.

- NCMS, through innovation and effective relationships, will provide its membership the tools

and core skills that will enable them to meet their most challenging endeavors as contractor and government industrial security professionals.

- To be recognized throughout industry and the government as the premier organization for the development and implementation of quality training programs in the area of industrial security management and security leadership;
- To ensure that our members strive for the highest degree of professional excellence; encourage the exchange of ideas and best practices between our members;
- To participate in national level working groups and committees to affect national security policies
- To help our members achieve the most challenging goals in the area of industrial security.

The Society is an active participant in national-level dialogue relevant to the National Industrial Security Program. NCMS provides input to government decision makers on crucial policy issues and assists in the development of regulatory documentation. NCMS members actively support the activities of key national committees addressing national security issues.

WHO COORDINATES SOCIETY ACTIVITIES?

The NCMS mission is supported entirely by volunteers. The Society’s business affairs are managed by a Board of Directors, elected by the membership. The Board of Directors annually elects the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. For all business and administrative functions, NCMS also has the full-time support of a professional association management company. The lead person serves as the Executive Director of NCMS.

The activities of the membership are coordinated by Chapter Chairpersons who lead over 3,000 security professionals intricately involved in the protection of the nation’s most critical secrets. A Chapter Liaison is appointed by the President to promote effective communication between the Board and the Chapter Chairpersons. The Chapter Liaison also provides support and operational guidance to the Chapter Chairs.

Standing committees, with oversight provided by the Board of Directors and staffed by the membership, are established to address specific security issues and business affairs of the Society. These committees address crucial national issues such as computer security, education and training, government and industry awareness, and international affairs.

ACTIVITIES

NCMS holds an annual three-day training seminar hosted at various locations around the country. National-level speakers are invited to speak on critical issues of concern ranging from counterintelligence to information security to security education and training. The Annual Seminar affords tremendous learning opportunities as well as a chance to meet fellow security professionals and to establish relationships that can be invaluable to members’ professional development.

NCMS maintains a web site at www.classmgmt.com. The contents of the site, much of which are available only to members, include useful security tools such as sample documents, products, and publications, job postings from around the country, member resumes, a library of the CM Bulletins (NCMS’ bimonthly publication) and useful reference materials, and much more.
